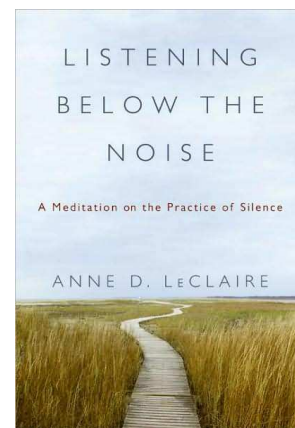
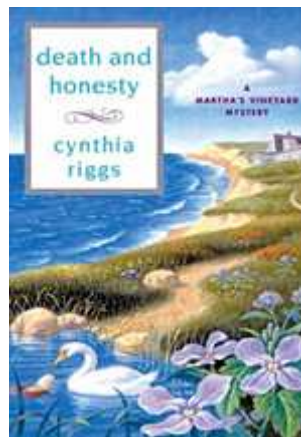
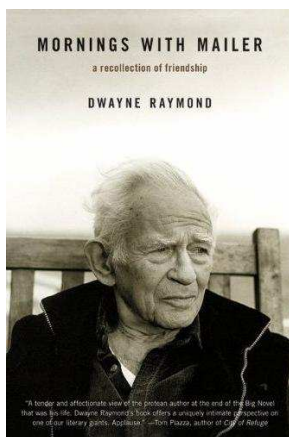

DWAYNE RAYMOND: *MORNINGS WITH MAILER*

Dwayne Raymond served as editorial assistant, friend and confidant to Norman Mailer for the last 5 years of his life. In this poignant memoir, Mr. Raymond presents an alternative portrayal of a writer who is frequently described as controversial, combative, and verbose; the Norman Mailer he depicts is a comparatively temperate, comprehensive man whose quirky, human qualities far outweigh the disquieting legend. Beautifully written and honestly portrayed, *Mornings with Mailer* is a personal and revealing story of a great writer, his Man-Friday, and their unlikely, but enduring, relationship.

CYNTHIA RIGGS: *DEATH AND HONESTY*

Cynthia Riggs is a 13th generation Islander, who began writing her popular Martha's Vineyard based mysteries in 2001. *Death and Honesty* is the 8th book in the series featuring her heroine Victoria Trumbull, the indomitable 92-year-old deputy police officer and poet, who investigates small town skullduggery. This "cozy" mystery has plenty of plot twists and turns to keep the reader thoroughly enthralled.

ANNE LECLAIRE: *LISTENING BELOW THE NOISE*

Author of nine books, Ms. LeClaire's latest, *Listening Below the Noise* describes her personal experiences of silent Mondays. She explores the soul's yearning for quiet, the ego's resistance to it, the intrusion of society, the lessons silence holds, and the healing it can effect. In addition she offers practical means of achieving peace and solace in a world in which these qualities are hard to come by. It was selected as one of the top 50 spiritual books of 2009 by "Spirituality & Practice."
