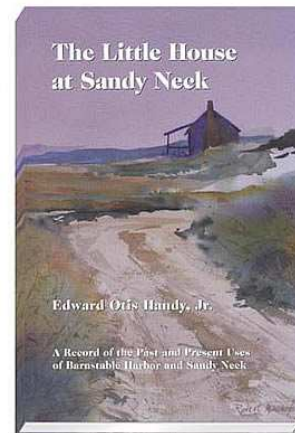
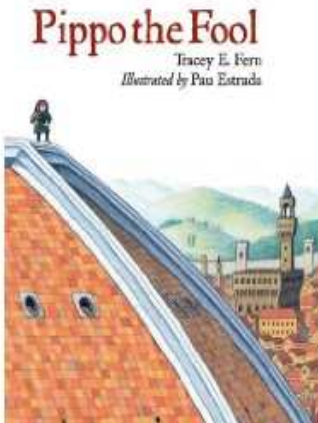
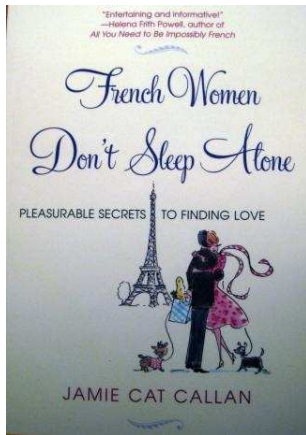


# CAPE COD WRITERS CENTER PRESENTS BREAKFAST WITH THE AUTHORS
